Parade Check-In & Start

Check-in begins: 7:00 a.m. - Oct 16, 2021

Check-in location: Harrison Street,
between Date and Cedar Streets, Taft

Start time: 10:00 a.m.

Parade route: South on 6th Street
starting at Ash Street;
East on Center Street at 6th Street;
Ending past Center & 2nd Streets

Entry Requirements

After your application has been received by Oildorado, you will receive a confirmation letter. Further information regarding line up and division information will be provided after the parade application deadline of October 1, 2021.

General

1. All entries must have an identifying sign/name of your group or entry on both sides.
2. Open flame devices are prohibited.
3. Decorated materials in the parade structure must be kept clear of the exhaust system of a motorized vehicle or float.
4. Never refuel a generator while it is operating or still hot. Avoid refueling by planning ahead and filling gas tank prior to event.
5. Be sure that the driver/operator has a clear field of view.
6. Candy or other items are **NOT** allowed to be thrown from the vehicles for safety reasons. Walkers may if they are close to the curb.
7. Please limit routines to 45-60 seconds in front of the judges stand (in front of Lincoln).

Floats/Trailers

1. Floats must be part of a fully decorated trailer that is self-propelled or pulled by vehicle.
2. If flatbed trailer or moving trailer, the bed should be covered or masked around the entire trailer and should have one-inch clearance.
3. All motorized floats should be equipped with a portable currently certified fire extinguisher that is readily accessible to the operator.
4. **NO** Candy may be thrown from float trailers.
